## APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

There are many variations in carpet fibers and carpet treatments which make it imperative that the user of this product determines its suitability.

1. Test the carpet protection film on a small inconspicuous area.
2. Leave in place for 48 hours and then inspect to ensure there is no change to the carpet.


 **NOTE:** This carpet protection film is designed for use on synthetic carpeting (not for use on natural fibers or other flooring). It is used for temporary surface protection during painting, remodeling, relocations or other high traffic situations.

 **NOTE:** The temporary usage period should not exceed 45 days.

 **NOTE:** This product is not recommended for use in high humidity areas or for outdoor use.

Application can be made easier by locating the tab at the beginning of the roll.

1. Pull the first few inches of the film and press to the carpet surface.
2. Pull the roll over the desired coverage area.
3. Apply pressure to the covered area to ensure the carpet protection remains in place.

 **NOTE:** DO NOT apply the carpet protection film on adjoining floor surfaces such as hardwood, vinyl or ceramic tile. It is not designed for this usage.

Store this product in a dry place, not to exceed 100°F or below 40°F.
