Straddle Stacker

Removal from Pallet-Instructions

- 1. Locate suitable lifting straps and ensure they are in good condition.
- 2. Loop straps around lifting bar on top of the Straddle Stacker using a step stool or rolling ladder.
- 3. Secure straps to forks.
 - a. Have driver raise forks to the height of lifting bar.
 - b. Slide end of straps around each fork.
 - c. Move forklift forward so straps are at least 1/3 onto forks.
 - d. Tilt forks up and raise forks until all slack is removed from straps.
- 4. Clear area around Straddle Stacker.
 - a. Check that the Straddle Stacker wheel brake is set.
 - b. Make sure all helpers and objects are out of the way of the forklift.
- 5. Lift Straddle Stacker 6 inches off the pallet.
- 6. Move forklift backwards away from the pallet to an open area.
- 7. Lower forks and set Straddle Stacker carefully on level ground.
- 8. Carefully remove straps from top of Straddle Stacker before using.
- *Caution: Do not stand next to forklift outriggers.
